

KG Assessment Policy

WE WOULD LIKE TO CALRIFY THAT OUR ASSESSMNET POLICY WAS ASSIGNED ACCORDING OUR STUDENTS NEEDS AND ABILITIES AND REGARDING SOME IMPORTANT PRINCIPELS.

Assessment is a continuous process integral to learning and teaching. It is how teachers gain knowledge of their pupils' needs, achievements and abilities, enabling planning and delivery to be more effective, thereby raising attainment for every child.

Principles of assessment are:-

- to provide information for target setting for individuals, groups and cohorts
- to provide information to support progression in learning through planning
- to share learning goals with children
- to involve children with self-assessment
- to help pupils know and recognize the standards they are aiming for
- to raise standards of learning
- to identify children for intervention
- to inform parents and other interested parties of children's progress
- to complete a critical self-evaluation of the school

Assessment for Learning

Assessment opportunities, which are a natural part of teaching and learning, are constantly taking place in the classroom through discussion, listening and analysis of work. It is essential that teachers know how well a

child has progressed and that pupils understand how well they are doing and what they must learn to help them improve.

To achieve this at GGIS School we will follow the next policy:

We would like to clarify the school policy concerning the students' assessment.

The KG section:

- The students will have ongoing assessment in the core subjects (English, math, science, and Arabic). They will take a test after each unit or chapter in math, science, and Arabic on their students' book.
- There would be only one test or quiz daily.
- The students have dictation in Arabic and English almost weekly at the end of (short vowels, long vowels, blends and diagraphs) as for Arabic.
- The students will be assessed in the non-core subjects once every quarter. They will take the exams during a whole week. Every day, they will take a test on one non-core subject.
- The core and non-core tests covered materials will be sent before the tests.
- Student will have revision sheets and revision sessions before the tests.
- The students will take the non-core tests during their normal periods in that testing week.

Absentees Policy :

- Any student who would be absent during a test, should bring a medical report the next day.
- The student will sit for the test the following day during break time.
